
## **Remote Keypad Installation Sheet**



The Remote Keypad is intended for use only when mounted on a cubicle door in the manner shown in this installation sheet. It is not suitable for handheld or remote use. Operation in any other fashion may cause a hazard and invalidates the warranty.

## 1 Items Supplied with the Remote Keypad

Figure 1-1 Items supplied with the Remote Keypad




- 1. Rubber seal
- 2. Clamping bracket
- 3. 6-pin connector cover
- 4. Mounting screws (x3)

## 2 Panel mounting


Figure 2-1 Panel cut out

Figure 2-1 below shows the dimensions of the cut-out required to mount the Remote Keypad on a panel or cubicle door.

- Fit the rubber seal around the Remote Keypad. 1.
- Position the Remote Keypad into the panel /cubicle cut-out.
- 3. Attach clamping bracket.
- 4. Insert the 3 x mounting screws and tighten to 0.6 N m (0.44 lb ft).
- 5. Insert the 6-pin connector cover.


The communications cable between the drive's RS485 port or KI-485 Adaptor and keypad is wired one-to-one.

The maximum cable length is 100 m when conductors of 0.129 mm<sup>2</sup> (AWG 26) or larger are used and the cable shield should be connected to the grounded panel / cubicle at the keypad end of the cable.



The 6-pin connector cover must be installed to prevent exposure to electrical circuits that may only be protected to ELV levels depending upon the type of drive used.

## 3 **Understanding the Keypads**



- Escape button
- Start reverse (Auxiliary button) 2.
- Start forward button
- Navigation keys (x4)
- 5. Stop / Reset (red) button
- 6. Enter button

- Escape button
- 2. Auto button
- 3. Hand button
- Navigation keys (x4)
- 5. Off / Reset (red) button
- Enter button

The red button is also used to reset the drive. For further details on the keypad please refer to the relevant Drive User Guide.
